THE STORY

The domain Brazillier is located at the heart of the Coteaux du Vendômois AOC, in Thoré-la-Rochette. The vines cover an area of 25 hectares and have been managed under sustainable values for many decades. The Coteaux du Vendômois vineyard belongs to the large family of Loire Valley vineyards. The vines are planted on hillsides, near the Loir river. The terroir - made of clay and silt, with limestone outcrops in places - is very fertile. It is this original terroir which gives the Coteaux du Vendômois wines their minerality and typicity.

Benoît Brazillier represents the seventh generation of winegrowers in his family. In 1997, he set up as an independent winemaker, with his father Jean, now retired.

Since then, the entire vineyard has been organically farmed.

The Domaine Brazillier cellar is made up of multiple vats, both above ground and underground. Next to the winery, cellars dug into the rock are also set up for making wine.
